### **Important Reminder About Bookings**

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children, please remember that:

- Children cannot sign themselves in.
- If your child does not have a booking, they cannot be dropped off without prior confirmation from the service.
- We are reaching capacity quite often, and by law we cannot exceed our licensed numbers.

If children are repeatedly brought to the service without a booking, your account may be suspended. We kindly ask for your cooperation to keep our service safe and compliant.

### **Bookings & Absences**

We kindly remind all families to use the Parent Portal to book or cancel OSHC sessions.

If your child is not attending, please ensure their absence is updated as early as possible before or on the day before the session starts. This helps us manage staffing, keep all children safe, and avoid unnecessary fees.

#### Please note:

When a child is booked in but doesn't arrive and we cannot reach a parent or emergency contact, we are required to escalate the situation, which may **involve contacting the**police to ensure the child's safety. We absolutely want to avoid this distressing step — timely updates help us greatly.



### DROP OFF & PICK UP REMINDER

#### SIGN IN/OUT PROCESS

All children are to be brought into the service and signed in/out by **Authorised Nominee(s) only**. Children are **not** to be dropped off and requested to sign themselves into the service without an Authorised Nominee(s) present.

\*\*NOTE: Authorised Nominee(s) **MUST** be 18 or over for your child to be released in their care\*\*

### ADDITIONAL AUTHORISED NOMINEES

Additional authorised nominees can be added through Parent Portal. If you have difficulties doing this, please contact the service and we will be happy to assist. If you do not wish to list the individual as an authorised nominee for regular pickups; it is your responsibility to ensure you are providing approval, in writing, to the service. The individual MUST present Photo ID to ensure your child can be released into their care. The responsible person on site will sign your child out on your behalf after confirming the individual matches the approval provided.

#### \*\* WE CAN BE FLEXIBLE \*\*

There is flexibility in special circumstances when dropping off or collecting your child. Should you require additional support due to unforeseen circumstances, please contact the service and arrangements will be made to ensure the safe delivery of your child to and from our service.

If you have any concerns regarding this process, you can contact us via Parent Portal, Email or Phone.

### ROAD SAFETY
